Roll Call; Board members Betty Ann Schildgen (Chair), Teresa Sirico (Vice-Chair), Joe Gullo, Lynn Ryczer, Logan Beirne (phone) and treasurer Tammy Mursko

Reading of the Minutes of May 24 and June 6, 2022. Teresa moved that they be accepted and Joe seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Report of the Chair: Budget Committee -Tammy Mursko, Ann Maher, Joe Gullo, Teresa Sirico. Nominating Committee- Gina Zappone, Pat McComish, T. Sirico, Dotti Arcovitch, J. Berkowitz. Ed Burns IV of Burns Construction cleared our walkways without charging us. Bruce Kuryla, Milford Harbor Master compiled a 9 page permit application to DEEP for a Regulatory Marker Permit for our swimming area after two owners contacted DEEP questioning whether a permit was required. Mr. Kuryla said he was glad to help us and there would be no charge. He is also helping us repair our shackles. We are indebted to these two individuals for their generous help.

We now have only 2 certified lifeguards, Ronald Kalbaj, and Connor DiMuro. A motion was made Teresa Sirico and seconded by Joe Gullo to appoint Ronald head guard at \$17 an hour and Connor DiMuro \$16 an hour. All were in favor. Another motion was made to close the beach Mondays and Tuesdays for No Lifeguards and post Swim at Your Own Risk signs. Teresa made the motion and Joe seconded the motion. Board unanimously approved. This may change if we are able to hire a third guard.

The Sign committee is viewing various signs. Regarding the Charter/Bylaw committee, Attorney Martelon spoke with State Senator James Maroney and will be meeting with the Chair of the committee Mary O'Connor next week. Brian Logan thanked Diane Gullo for her addition of flowers for the Garden on the Green. The Board agreed that the Garden looked very nice.

Treasurer Tammy Mursko reported that we are in good financial condition. Assessments are owed on 56 houses and 4 lots.

Old Business-The Board will request police work on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July from 5:30-10:30  
The Annual Meeting will be held at Calf Pen Meadow School. Insurance paperwork has been submitted.  
Teresa is still trying to find someone to build a new bulletin board at Westland Ave.

New Business- The Beach Mat committee has submitted a request for an additional \$156.17 for an 8 foot mat extension for the handicapped mat at the new location across from 87 Bayshore Dr. Teresa made a motion to purchase the mat extension. Joe seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

A discussion took place regarding dogs on the beach. We will ask the Dog Catcher and Police Department for their help again.

The Board is looking for winter storage of lifeguard stands and a company to remove the stands at end of summer and replace them the next year. Lynn and Teresa volunteered to help with this project.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made at 7:25 p.m. by Joe Gullo seconded by Teresa. All were in favor.
