Roll Call:

Logan Beirne (Chair), Teresa Sirico (Vice Chair), Elizabeth Schildgen (via phone), Kevin Gilbert and Laura Hanifin. Also in attendance were Jill Evans (Treasurer) and Alison Gilbert (Interim Clerk)

Reading of Minutes from Oct. 13, 2025:

There were no corrections. Teresa made the motion to approve the minutes and Laura seconded. All board members were in favor.

Report of Chairman:

1. Logan thanked Jill and Alison for stepping in to their new roles. They have hit the ground running.
2. Laura has been working with Gabby on the website. A QR code linked to an on-line application has been posted for lifeguard positions.

Lifeguard applications are coming in. Laura is in touch with coaches and instructors.
3. Logan said the water treatment plant problem is moving in the right direction. Many thanks to Patricia Houser, Rachel Petitti, Sharon Joslin, Valerie Donahue and Barbara Herman who were key in moving this forward.
4. Garden committee will seek estimates (including Top Seed) to maintain our green. Logan will reach out. Garden committee is willing to maintain the flagpole garden. Kevin will wrap the bottom of the legs on our sign to prevent lawn mower damage.

Report of Clerk:

1. The spring mailing is almost ready to be mailed out.
2. Two liens have been released since December, 2025.
3. Almost \$3,000 in back due taxes may be collected soon due to a foreclosure.

Report of Treasurer:

1. Jill asked where the lien chart comes from. Logan said he will ask the attorney to send it to her.
2. She also asked permission to move money from one account to another to pay bills. The answer is yes, she can.
3. The general budget was discussed.

Old Business:
