

Bayview Board of Governor's Meeting

NOVEMBER 9,2020 (Via Zoom) 6:30p.m.

Roll Call: Board Members Elizabeth Schildgen (Chair), Teresa Sirico (Vice-Chair), Jo Gullo, Tom Torello, Lynn Ryczer. Clerk Dotti Arcovitch and Treasurer Tammy Mursko were also present.

Reading of the Minutes OF October 5,2020: Joe moved the minutes be accepted as read, Teresa seconded and all were in favor.

Report of the Chair: Since our last meeting Jennifer Ruspini, 1 Bayshore Drive, who volunteered to design a website for Bay View, refused to turn over the website, saying it was hers and she owned it. After much drama Jennifer resigned and pulled her website down. The website committee met and is now working on a new website: Bayviewimprovementassociation.org with a good plan and organization.

Report of the Clerk: Three liens have been released this month.

Report of the Treasurer: Tammy has spoken to the accountant and it was decided the buoys and boat racks will be taken from the Beach Maintenance line item. Teresa moved to accept the Treasurer's report. Joe seconded and all were in favor.

Old Business: Buoys are needed in the area of Milesfield and Westland Ave and new lines between the buoys on the main beach. The old buoys were never returned. The life guard stands are still on the beach due to the ongoing construction in the area. Tom has called everyone regarding removal of the boats from the racks. (95 Orland St. has not complied with the requirement to remove the boats and will move to the end of the line to reserve a spot next year.)

New Business: Gabby Diego, 28 Milesfield Ave. has volunteered to be webmaster for Bay View and has provided the following: the site is Wix Site. The cost is \$276 per year for the first 10 years and \$198.90 for the domain name for a total of &474.90 the first year. Betty Ann moved we appoint Gabby and pay the cost. Joe seconded and all were in favor. Teresa moved we pay Gabby's dues in consideration. Tom seconded and all were in favor.

Centennial Committee: Tammy reported the committee met on Oct. 24 and will meet again on Nov. 17. They are trying to coordinate with the Recreation Committee and some funds will come from the recreation budget. They have many ideas and will keep the Board updated. The Board is supportive of their plans.

Teresa moved to adjourn at 7:15 pm. Joe seconded and all were in favor.
