

## **Bayview Board of Governor's Meeting**

**May 24, 2021 21 Warren Street 6:30p.m.**

**Roll Call:** Board Members Elizabeth Schildgen (Chair), Joe Gullo, Tom Torello, Lynn Ryczer and Treasurer Tammy Mursko and Clerk Dotti Arcovitch were present.

**Reading of the Minutes of April ,2021:** Tom moved the minutes be accepted as read, Joe seconded and all were in favor.

**Report of the Chair:** Teresa and Betty Ann met with Attorney Benedosso and Attorney Martelon May 10<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 am. Attorney Martelon gave us a new lien form which we can use now and in the future.

**Report of the Clerk:** Over half of the membership have paid their dues at this time.

**Report of the Treasurer:** Three people have paid \$170 instead of the \$150 currently due. They will be reimbursed the extra \$20.

**Old Business:** Re Lifeguards: Joe moved that we hire Dominic Rusu at \$13 per hour and Lynn seconded. All were in favor. Since we now have only 2 lifeguards it was suggested that we put up a sign: "SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK" if another is not hired. It was also decided that "BEACH TAGS REQUIRED" be added to new signs. Regarding the Fence: Babcock Fence is operating 15 weeks out and can't get supplies at this time. Joe made a motion that we accept Reliable Fence's bid of \$4,011 to replace the areas on Bayshore and Oakland most in need at this time saying "it is the only thing that will last in a storm." Tom seconded and all were in favor. Lynn mentioned that she will need retainers for some recreation activities and will inform Tammy when needed. Betty Ann read letters from members; one praised the Board for all they do and one was critical of Beach restrictions. A new Little Library has been placed behind the Oakland bulletin board.

**New Business:** The beach will be opened on June 20<sup>th</sup> but then closed for the day on June 21 due to the lack of lifeguards. The two guards are willing to work six days a week. Betty Ann will order shirts for the lifeguards. Tom will get new beach umbrellas, garbage pails and arrange for the dumpster to be delivered. Joe will ask Montez Landscaping to remove the beach roses which are too near the boat rack and transplant them elsewhere. The main entrance could also use some repair. The plans for the Centennial event were discussed. Joe stated that we should increase the budget since it is "only once in 100 years" and suggested \$7000. Tom seconded and all were in favor. It was also decided that two police officers should be hired for the event.

Tom moved to adjourn at 7:40 pm. Joe seconded and all were in favor.
